# Spearhead Cluster (SPC)

- Actual situation
  - 5 SPC's
  - Started 1/1/2017:
    - Catalisti: former FISCH (sustainable chemistry)
    - VIL: logistic
    - SIM: materials
    - Flux50: energy
  - To start 1/1/2018:
    - Agrofood: former Flanders'Food + Agro

# SPC versus Light Structures

- SPC: Government support for central organisation
  - Max 50 % of accepted costs
  - Max 500 k€/annum
  - Matching 1€ / 1 € support of industry
  - 10 years support
- LS: Government support for central organisation was:
  - Max 80 % of total cost
  - Max. 640 k€/annum
  - Min. 6 FTE employed

# Role of the SPC

- Much broader scope - not only R&D
  - One stop shop
  - Mandate over its area
  - Market oriented / also shorter term (valorisation) activities
  - Interaction/collaboration with Vlaio ( Vlaio account manager)
- Inter cluster collaboration
- Transition areas
  - Circular economy
  - Energy
  - Internationalisation
  - Industry 4.0

# SPC earmarked budget use

- Focus on more downstream activities
- Much broader scope of fundable activities
- No longer only research

# IBN's versus SPC

IBN = Innovatief Bedrijven Netwerk (innovative companies network)

- Scope 3 years
- No earmarked budget
  
- IBN can be active in fields not covered by an SPC
- IBN's can be active within the field of SPC's; temporarily boosting some specific activities

# New Project types

- Ruling under development
- 2017 transition year under old/existing ruling
  - Call 14
  - New call open ! Will close in September to be able to agree on the projects before the end of 2017

# Poster Award – voting system: VoxVote



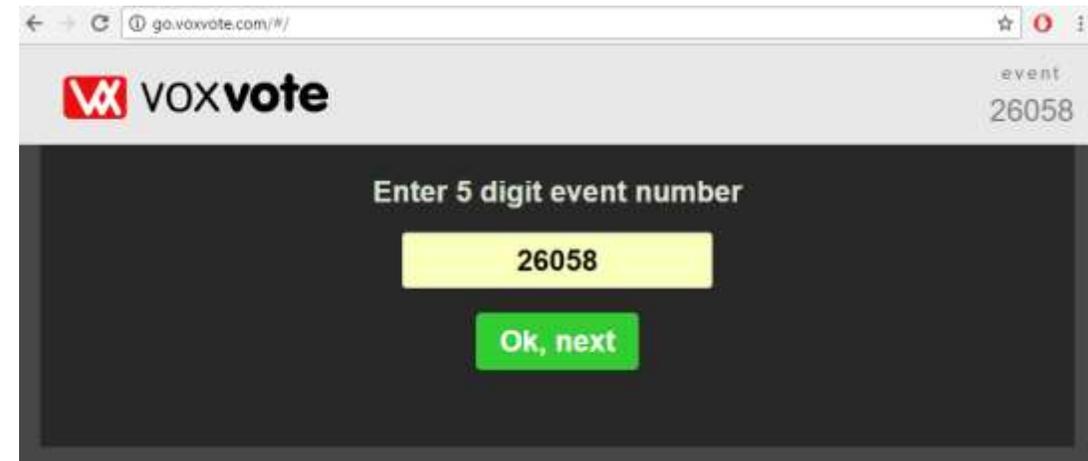
- First voting round:
