

When you submit a Poster for the SIM User Forum on 22/05/2019

- Posters need to be linked to SIM-Programs or SIM-supported projects (Intercluster or Transition priorities).
- If you want to present a poster, consider the following

17 May, 9h00	Send the final pdf version of your poster to SIM (*) and let us know if you compete for the Poster Award (answered "yes" during Registration)	x	x

- Please make sure that posters related to projects in SIM-programs have received prior approval by the Program IP-board.
- Poster presenters are responsible for printing their own posters.
- Posters should be **A0-sized** and **portrait-oriented**.
- [SIM's logo](#) must be placed on the poster.
- On 22 May 2019 presenters can set up their posters between 12h and 14h
- On 22 May 2019 presenters stay with their poster during the Poster Session (15h – 16h20)

When you compete with your Poster for the SIM Poster Award

- Only the first author needs to register for the Poster Award and needs to be a PhD student active in and paid on a SIM project.
- The presence of at least one Poster author is required during the Poster Session (15h00-16h20) and is optional during the Materials Market (14h15-17h15).
- If your poster is nominated for the SIM Poster Award, keep in mind that one of the authors has to give a short presentation (2 min. max – without slides) to the audience. During this "elevator pitch" the pdf of your poster will be projected on screen.
